GOD'S PURPOSE... MY CALLING

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DISCOVERING YOUR PASSION *Reflective Questionnaire*

Pay attention to what brings you joy. If you don't know your purpose, look for your passion (the things that bring you great joy and a sense of fulfillment); your passion will lead you directly to your purpose.

- Micah 6:8; Habakkuk 2:2-3; Ephesians 1:11, 10; Philippians 13:4

Take time to prayerfully reflect on the following questions. Begin by jotting down brief answers in the margins. Then refine your thoughts and transfer them to the last page. Keep your responses short and concise.

1. As a follower of Christ...

- What specific aspect of Christ's ministry resonates most deeply with you? (Healing, teaching, serving, confronting injustice, etc.)
- Which Scripture passage or biblical story speaks most to your heart and why?
- If you could dedicate the rest of your life to serving God, what specific activity would you pursue?

2. People groups

- Is there a particular people group, region, or community that you feel deeply drawn to? (Children, widows, immigrants, urban poor, unreached tribes, untouchables in India, etc.) Why?
- What social, cultural, or spiritual challenges faced by these groups resonate most deeply with you or burden your heart the most?
- Have you ever felt a specific urge to pray, support, or serve a particular people group? If so, describe that experience.

3. **Social issues**

- Which social issues are you most passionate about addressing? (Poverty, homelessness, human trafficking, mental health, etc.)
- When you hear about global crises or injustices, which ones stir your spirit the most?
- How do you believe the Church can play a role in addressing this issue?

4. **Practical acts of compassion**

- What are some practical acts of kindness or compassion you feel compelled to do?
- Do you enjoy working hands-on to help others, or do you feel more effective in organizing or supporting efforts behind the scenes?
- When you think about past experiences of serving others, what brought you the greatest joy or fulfillment?

5. **Spiritual gifts**

- What abilities or spiritual gifts do you have that you feel most confident using?
- Are there skills or areas of expertise that you'd like to develop further to serve God's purposes?
- How do others affirm or recognize your gifts in service or ministry?

6. **Challenges to overcome**

- What spiritual battles or challenges have shaped your faith?
- Are there specific struggles that you relate to because of your own journey?
- How has God redeemed your past to bring glory to Him and serve others?

7. **Prayer**

- What do you think about most often in prayer?
- What prayer topic stirs the deepest emotion or ignites the greatest passion in your heart?
- When you reflect on your life, what recurring theme or desire keeps coming to mind?

8. My role in the Body of Christ

- How do you see your role in the Body of Christ? (Encourager, servant, leader, missionary, prayer warrior, etc.)
- How do you feel about working in partnership with others versus individually?
- In what ways do you feel called to disciple others or mentor the next generation?

9. Leaving a legacy

- If there were no limitations such as money, time, or fear of failure, what would you do to make the greatest impact in the lives of others and for God's Kingdom?
- What legacy do you want to leave?
- Imagine standing before Christ. What is the one thing you hope He says about how you fulfilled your purpose on earth?

10. Taking the first step

- What's one step you can take now toward exploring or pursuing your passion?
- Describe how your life would be transformed if you were fully committed to pursuing your passion.
- In what ways can your passion draw others closer to Christ and contribute to the expansion of His kingdom?
